Commissioner Wallace moved, seconded by Commissioner Cline, to recognize Chief Ryan for his dedicated service as a firefighter and officer. Also to Recognize Assistant Chief Dupra for his service.

Administrator's Report

- -Three individuals have completed T.I.P.S. training and a liability insurance rider has been placed.
- -NYSDEC completed a 3-year inspection of the underground fuel storage tank. One small issue had been rectified.
- -DEC now requires a one-million-dollar Proof of Financial Responsibility relative to the underground tank. The district is anticipating receiving a cost quote.
- -Researching water service issues relative to the carriage house and property at 19. North Main Street.

Commissioner Schenkel moved, seconded by Commissioner Cline, the board authorized Administrator Ockenden to provide a resolution to maintaining suitable water service to the carriage house in an amount up to \$15,000.00. The resolution may also rectify water delivery service to 19 North Main Street.

The cost in 2025 will be \$3,607.00.
