Commissioner Wallace called the meeting to order at 7:00 PM with the Pledge of Allegiance and a moment of silence for fallen first responders and men and women in the armed forces serving around the world, and for Binghamton Firefighter John Gaudet who gave his life in the line of duty.

Chiefs' Report

- -Reported 70 calls year to date. Pittsford crews responded to a house fire on Callingham where two victims succumbed.
- -Recommended approval of new apparatus operators.
- -Explorers have been given access to BRYX response software with appropriate guidelines
- -Recommended that the district replace an aging and defective smoke machine used for mask confidence training.
- -Recommend that obsolete fire police gear be declared surplus
- -Requested authorization for firefighters to attend the upcoming FDIC
- -Attended the town Emergency Services Committee meeting with Assistant Chief Clouser. He reported that Anthony Caruso has been appointed town Fire Marshal.
- -Requested that members taking classes at PSTF have use of a district vehicle when needed.
- -Monroe County will terminate the digital paging system at year end.
- -The joint line and board meeting has been slated for February 19th.

Commissioner Schenkel moved, seconded by Commissioner Khalil, the board approved operators for apparatus as they had met training requirements:

Rescue 388: B. Garber, T. Joerger, J. Long

Squad 386: W. Schenkel

The motion carried by an Aye vote of commissioners present. Commissioner Schenkel abstained from voting on the approval of W. Schenkel.

Commissioner Schenkel moved, seconded by Commissioner Khalil, the board approved the purchase of a smoke machine at a cost of \$2,587.49.

Commissioner Wallace moved, seconded by Commissioner Schenkel, the board designated as surplus specific fire police equipment that is obsolete or beyond repair and is of no further value to the fire district.

Commissioner Cline moved, seconded by Commissioner Khalil, the board approved the participation of firefighters at the Fire Department Instructors Conference to be conducted April 6th to 12th. Transportation will be by commercial airline and district vehicle. Hotel, registration, and necessary expenses were authorized.

- -Requested approval of three station attendants. Each had been reviewed by the fire chief.
- -Authorized Personnel Only signs have been placed to delineate areas accessible to the public.
- -Proposals for repair or replacement of the station 1 radio room HVAC system are being reviewed.
- -Researching tables for the station 1 large meeting room.

Commissioner Schenkel moved, seconded by Commissioner Cline, the board approved an agreement with the Town of Pittsford to utilize station 2 as a polling place on June 24th and November 4th.
